We create multi-disciplinary, ensemble-celebrating performances that investigate new possibilities in narrative, audience engagement, and theatrical space. We have worked site-specifically in locations ranging from a parking garage (*Fool for Love*) to a former military barracks (*THE TRIP's Macbeth*) to one of San Diego's hottest tattoo shops (*Three Plays in a Tattoo Shop*), where an audience member was (willingly!) tattooed as part of the performance. La Jolla Playhouse has supported two major productions by the company: a backyard barbecue staging of Thornton Wilder's *Our Town* and Chekhov's *Three Sisters* on a tennis court. The Trip's *Orpheus & Eurydice*, a multi-platform adaptation of the myth through online content, live performance, and film, was nominated for Best New Play by the San Diego Critics Circle in 2014 and has subsequently toured to NYC and to Columbus, OH. In collaboration with La Habra Theater Guild, a youth theater organization in Los Angeles, THE TRIP created a bilingual adaptation of Dickens' *A Christmas Carol* and have made ten shows to date. Most recently, in 2018, THE TRIP created *This might be the end* at Theaterlab, who hosted development of the company's latest project, *PARADISE*, in July 2019 through a Hotel New Work Residency.
